- Forward completed forms (records) to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Animal Industry (the Department) within 7 days of application of tags.
 - Create and maintain records of tags applied, using form Record of Official Individual Identification Applied to Cattle in Florida, FDACS-09255, unless tags are provided by the owner.
 - Ensure that ear tag and other identification (as specified in 5C-31, F.A.C.) information is correctly correlated to the owner/premises of origin of the cattle.
 - Ensure that tags provided by an owner are applied only to cattle belonging to that owner.
 - Allow inspection by the Department during any tagging process.
 - Make all tagging records available to the Department as needed.
 - Report any change in management or contact information to the Department.
 - Retain records for five (5) years.
