IMPLIED CONSENT WARNING

316.1932 F.S.

The following statement(s) shall be read to the subject under arrest for DUI:

“You are required by Florida Statutes to submit to a chemical test to determine your blood alcohol content. This test is being given to you as a result of you being charged with the offense of driving while under the influence and is not being given to you as a continuation of a crash report in this case.”

BREATH TEST

“I am now requesting that you submit to an approved test of your breath for the purpose of determining the alcoholic content of your breath.”

URINE TEST

“I am now requesting that you submit to a test of your urine for the purpose of determining the presence of any chemical or controlled substance.”

BLOOD TEST

“I am now requesting that you submit to an approved test of your blood for the purpose of determining the alcoholic content of your blood.”

“Your failure to submit to any lawful test of your breath, urine, or blood will result in the suspension of your privilege to operate a motor vehicle for a period of 1 year for a first refusal, or for a period of 18 months if your driving privilege has been previously suspended as a result of a refusal to submit to such a test or tests. If you refuse to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine, or blood and your driving privilege has been previously suspended for a prior refusal to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine, or blood, you commit a misdemeanor in addition to any other penalties. The refusal to submit to a chemical or physical test upon the request of a law enforcement officer as provided in the statute is admissible into evidence in any criminal proceeding.”

“Will you take the test?” Subject stated yes Subject stated no

If the subject stated no, ask the subject the following:

“Do you still refuse to submit to this test knowing your driving privilege will be suspended for a period of at least one year?”

Subject stated yes, indicating they still refused to take the test

Subject stated no, indicating they would take the requested test
